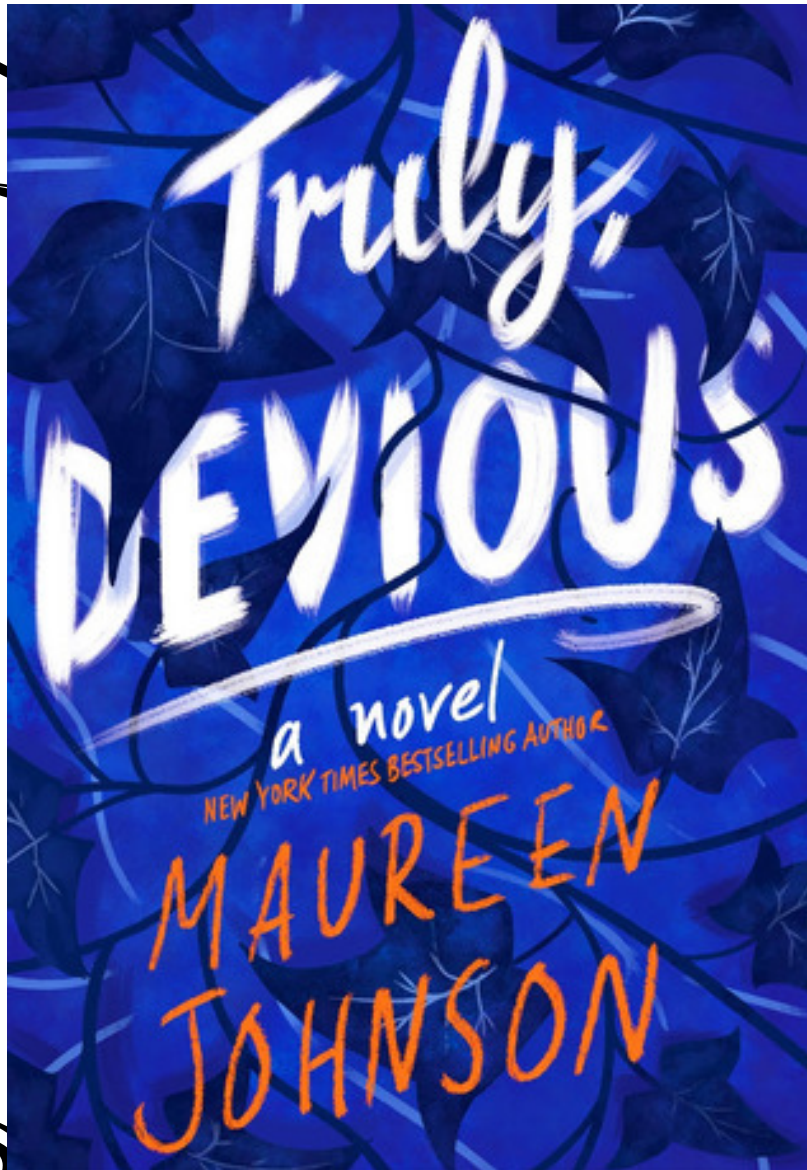

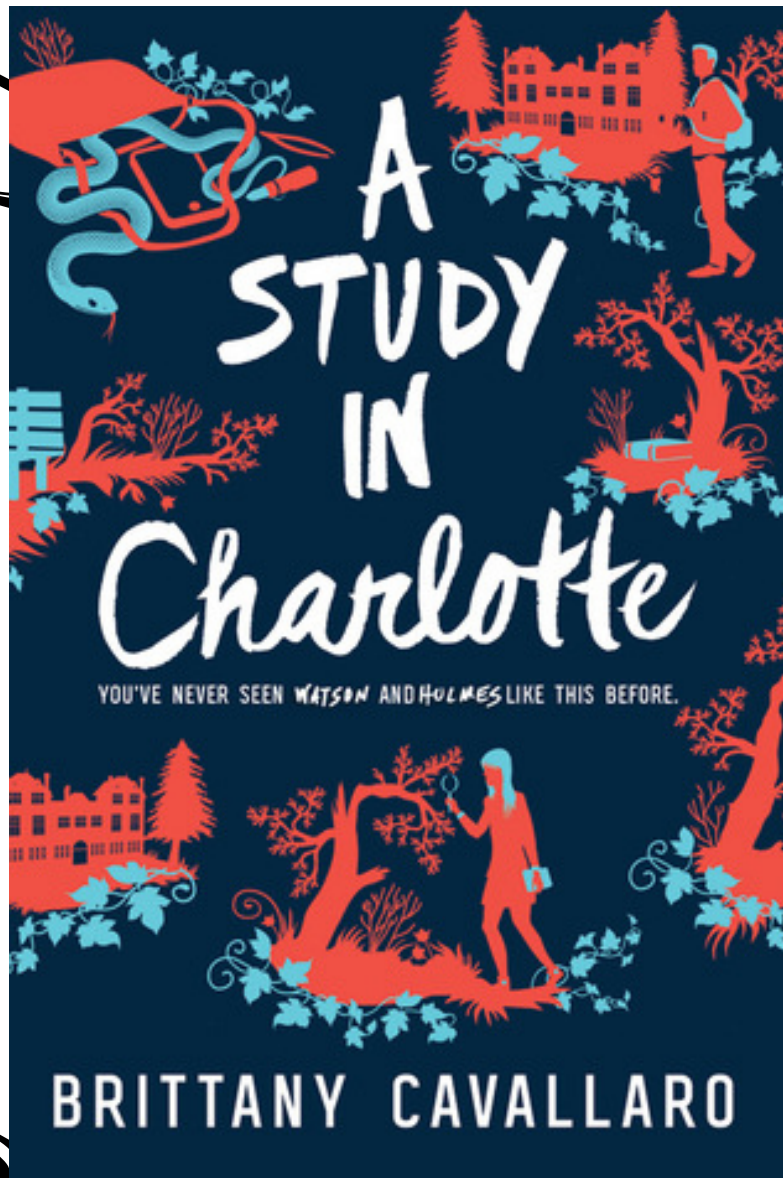

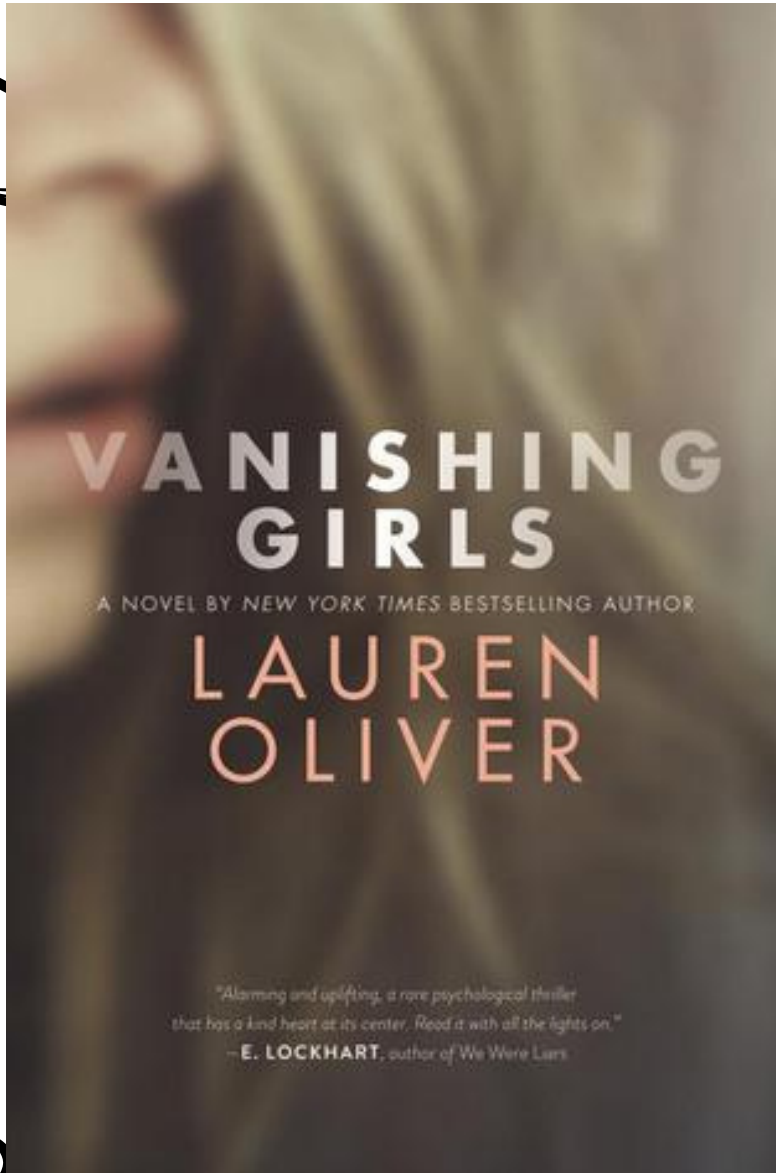
A STUDY IN CHARLOTTE

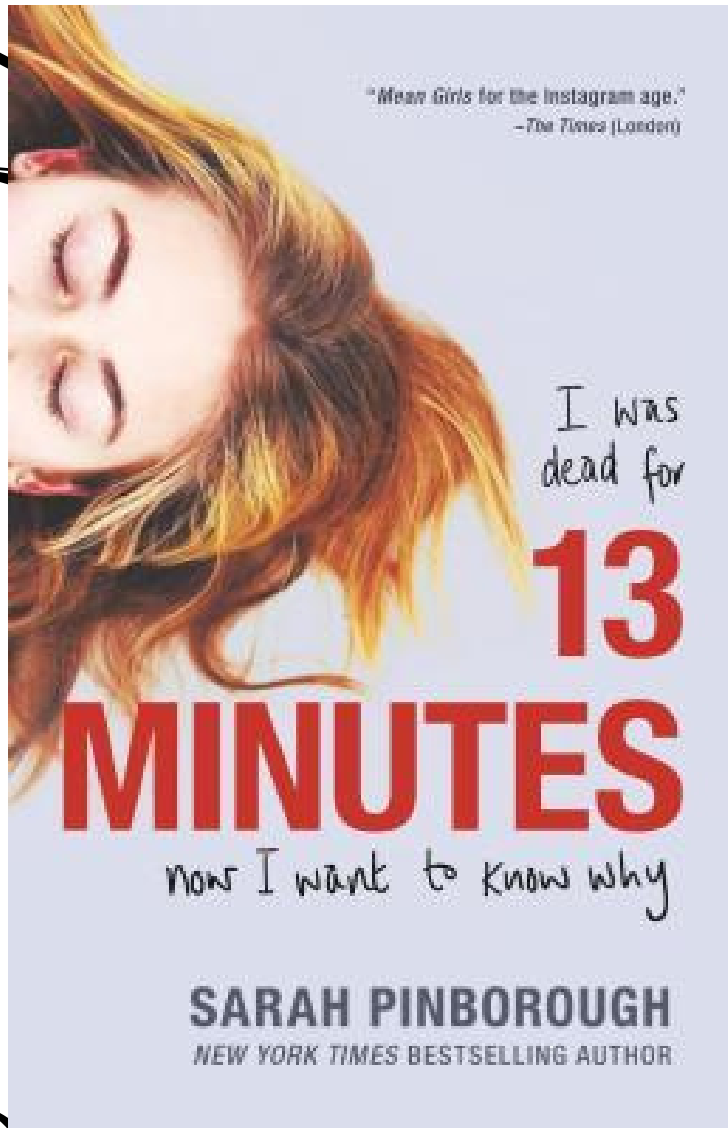

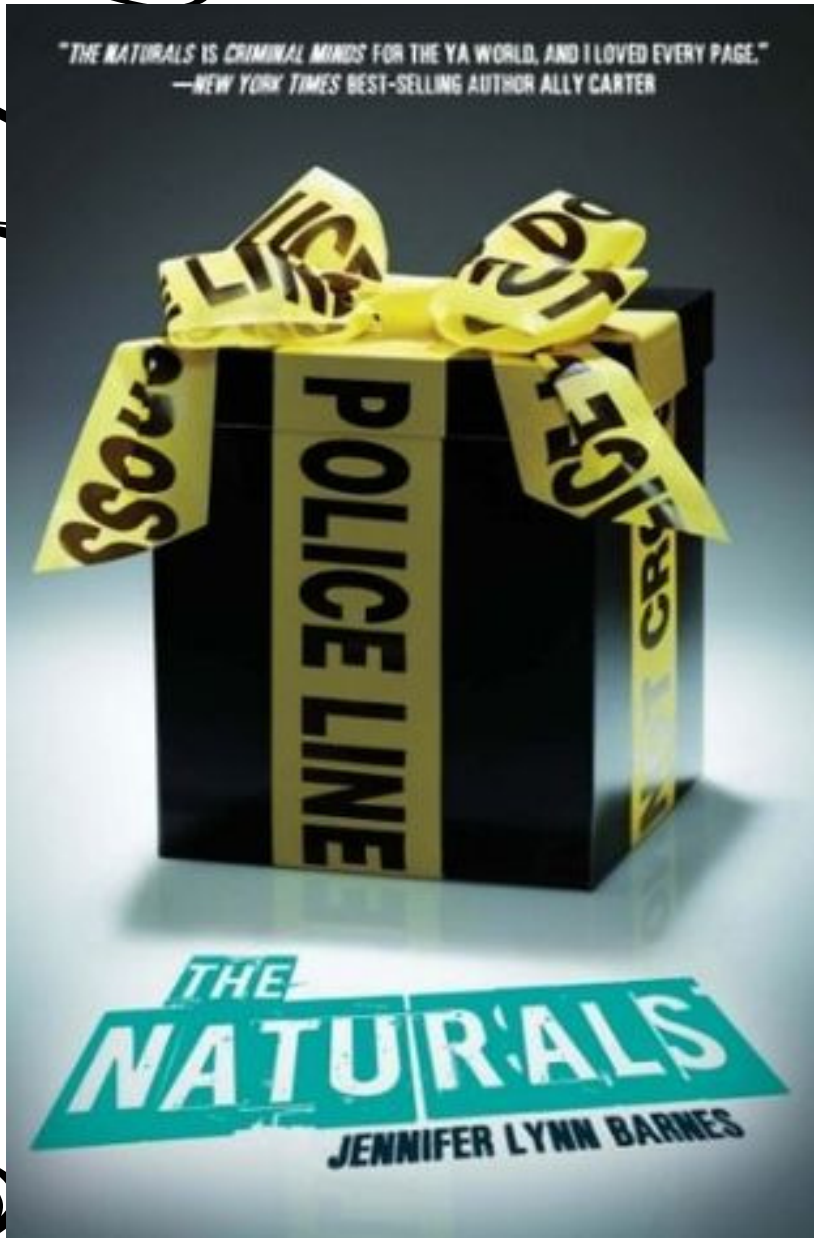
13 MINUTES

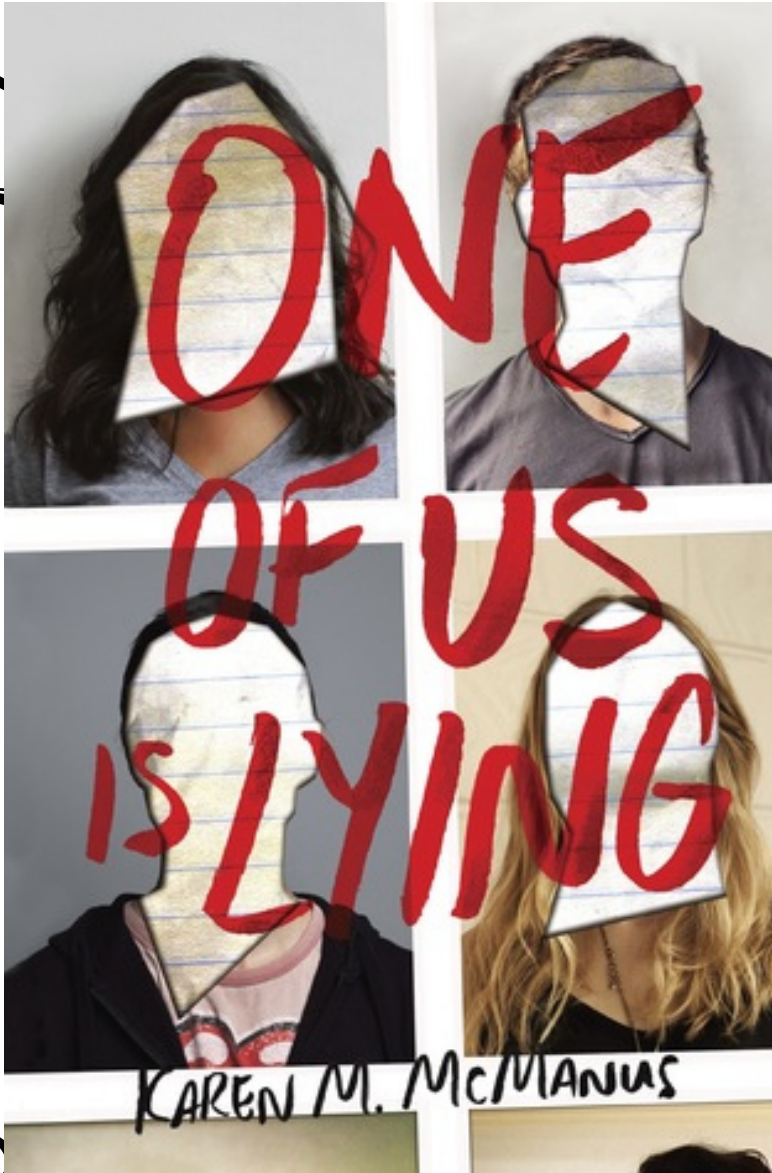

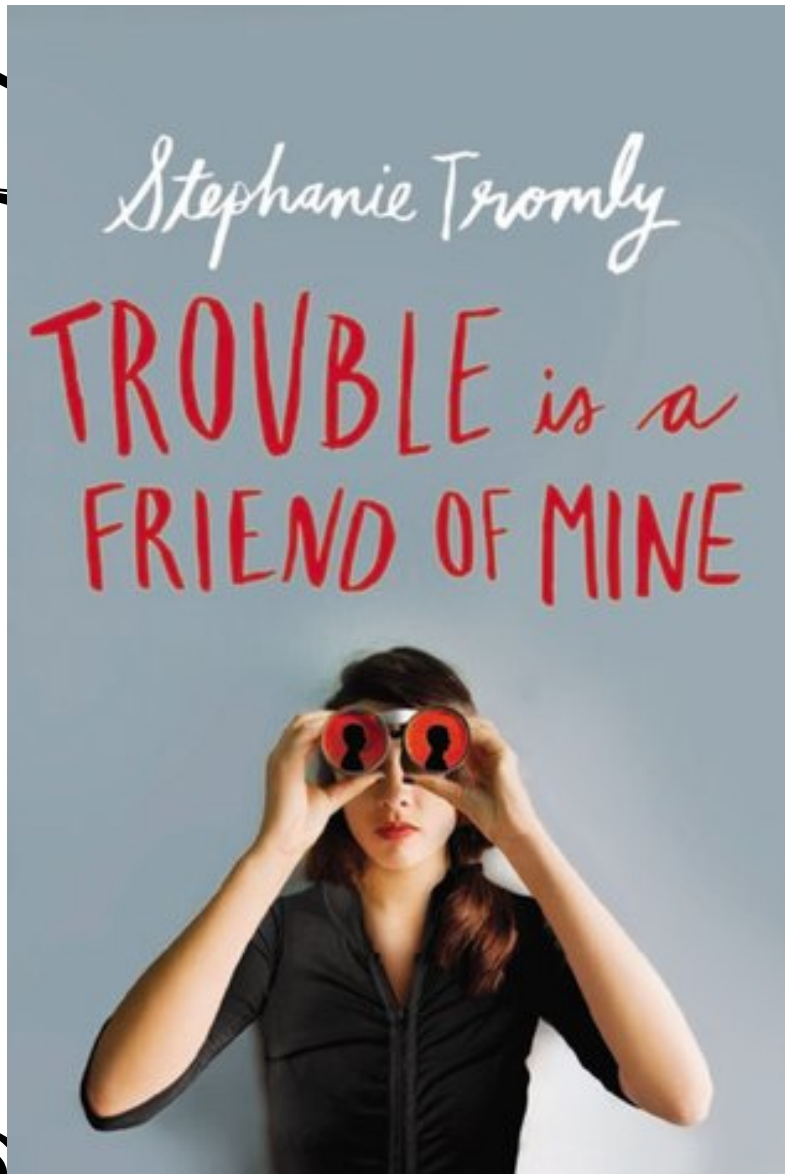
